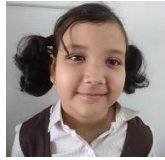

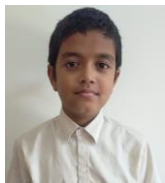
## ANDAMAN ISLANDS – LIKE PEARLS IN A SEA

Makes all equal – the rich, the poor all in cahoots.



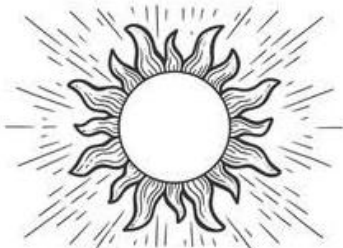

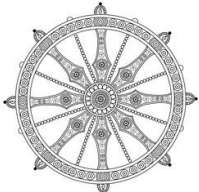

He completed his post-graduation from Utkal University, Bhubaneswar in History and M.Ed. from Berhampur University. His career began in the SCB Medical Public School, Cuttack as a Teacher in History and later continued with DAV Senior Secondary School, Ranchi, and DPS Nigahi, M.P. He joined ABPS Rayagada in 2011 as the founder Principal and did an excellent job of bringing laurels to the school. During his tenure at ABPS Rayagada, the school got many awards in academics and sports at the district and national levels. As the founder Principal, Mr. Dash worked diligently and got the school affiliated to the CBSE. Under his guidance, the school received National Award in CBSE Science Exhibition in 2019-20. 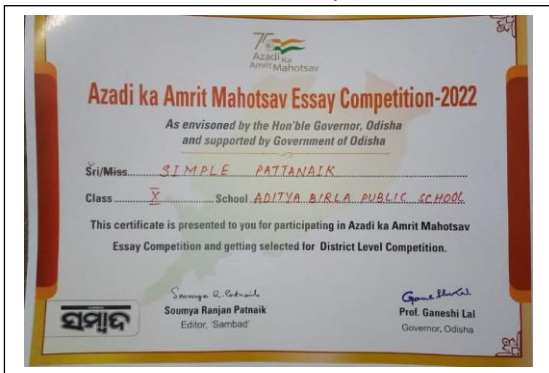

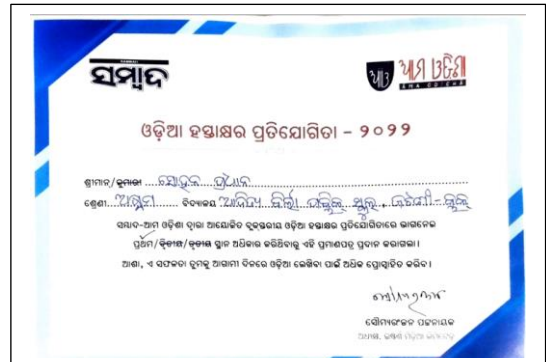

## Best Class of the Month:

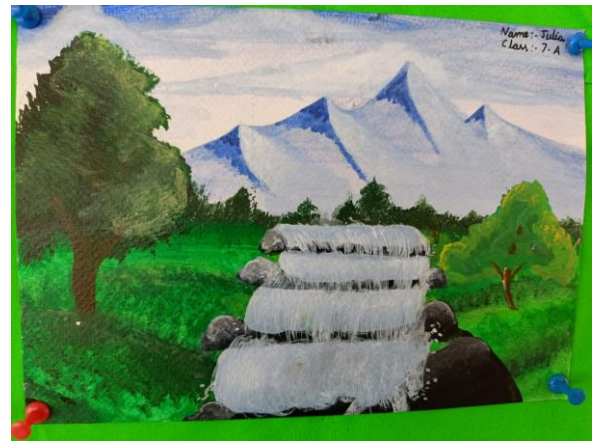

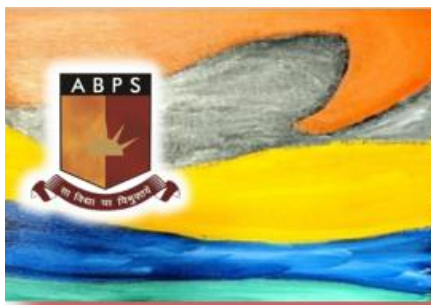

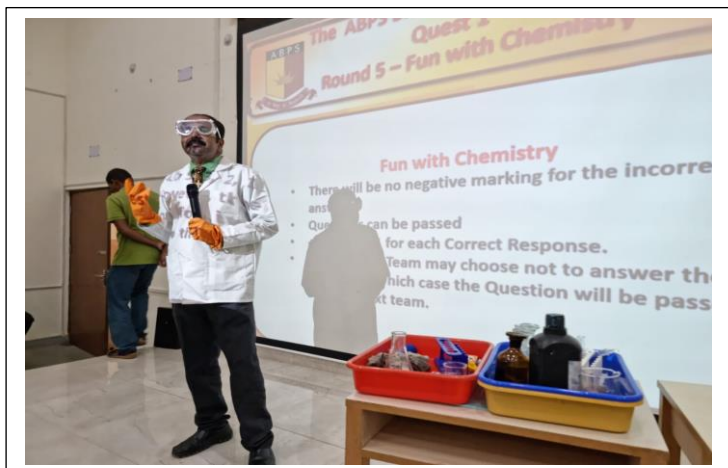
