Aims and Objectives

The curriculum developed for Classes Play class to UKG aims athelping the child to unfold his/her talents, to facilitate and guidethe child to sharpen his mental and physical abilities. It helps to enhance the learning, speaking, writing and listening skills of thechild.

The programme is based on a child - centred approach where inthrough play-waythe basic concepts are taught. The mainemphasis is placed on the child's experiences and interaction.

A typical day in Classes Play Group to UKG starts with the morningprayer followed by a 15 minutes free/ general conversationsession during which the children will get an opportunity to sharetheir experiences at home and outside the school. During thistime, major news items at national level as well as the school andfamily related issues will be discussed.

At the end of each day, 15 minutes will be devoted to rhyme and storytelling sessions. A general conversation based on the topic of the month is also done. The general conversation also includes moral education, vocabulary building and other relevant topics.

All the festivals will be discussed with the children as and whenthey occur. How and why they are celebrated will be discussed along with their significance. The syllabus thus aims at an all roundpersonality development to guide the child to develop himself as abetter human being.
